

Corona measures at the start of the academic year 2021-2022

GENERAL

- Mouth mask on when circulating (in classrooms, in halls, in corridors)
- Mouth mask off if there is a distance of 1,5 meters (or in case of fixed positions: leave one chair free)
- Club Conservatorium: catering rules
 - mouth mask on when circulating
 - remove mouth mask when eating/drinking at a table

THEORY CLASSES

- Mouth mask can only be removed when you are sitting down and a distance of at least 1,5 meter is possible. (This measure is constantly evaluated and can be adapted if necessary).

ARTISTIC PRACTICE

- When entering and leaving the room:
 - Wear a mouth mask
 - Disinfect hands
- During activities (dance, drama, movement):
 - No mouth mask
 - Try to keep as much distance as possible
- Music classical/singing, woodwinds and brass instruments:
 - Same distance measures: lecturer/student: at least 1,5 meter
- As part of the risk management strategy, the prevention department is organizing bi-weekly test moments on campus for students and teachers (except for people with CST or negative test result that is still valid).
- **ARE YOU SICK OR DO YOU HAVE COVID SYMPTOMS? DO NOT COME TO CAMPUS AND TAKE A TEST via contact tracing.**

INTERNATIONAL

- Anyone coming from abroad is required to fill in the Passenger Locator Form.
- If testing is necessary, student/staff member will receive an SMS => test centre in Central Station (UZA): <https://www.uza.be/traveltest-en>

- If you have symptoms, you have to contact AP for contact tracing via coronatracing@ap.be or 03/220.59.99 => code for testing.

PUBLIC ACTIVITIES

- Max 200 spectators
- Mouth masks are compulsory in hallways and during circulation
- If audience is seated: no mouth mask, no distance
- Reservations are obliged and there is a check at the entrance: name and mobile number or email address
- Send attendee lists to Production (ilse.muysers@ap.be)
- Inform Prevention Service via preventie@ap.be

IN CASE OF INFECTION

- You must report everything relating to COVID via corona tracing AP coronatracing@ap.be; you high-risk contacts will be informed from there.

Is there anyone who feels ill and has COVID symptoms?

1. Request a code test via coronatracing@ap.be or 03/220.59.99.
2. Students inform their teacher.
3. Staff members inform their manager and Jodka Crabbe via jodka.crabbe@ap.be.

Did anyone test positive?

- The whole group must be quarantined.
- All high-risk contacts must be tested, including those who have been fully vaccinated.
- They remain in quarantine until the result of the first test is received.
- If the result is negative, the quarantine can generally be ended. However, a second test is still necessary.
- In the event of a test refusal, a full ten-day quarantine must be observed.
- **In the case of a cluster with at least one breakthrough infection (= infection despite full vaccination), this exception does not apply and the full 7-day quarantine remains in place, even for fully vaccinated persons.**
